Reddish clay with a white slip, painted in red, black and pink pigments

### Description

Ref. Schloss, Ancient Chinese Ceramic Sculpture, 1977, plate 123. This tomb sculpture represents a standard of feminine beauty in the first half of the eighth century. She stands erect, hands folded under long sleeves, her face turned slightly, framed by a large hairdo that serves to call attention to the heaviness of her cheeks. (HFJ Handbook)
