## Description

Covered-box type of vessel on a high, straight footrim with a band of three incised lines connecting foot and body. The dome lid has a knob finial surrounded by two raised concentric rings and a collar of palm fronds radiating from the center. The base is decorated with palm fronds and each leaf is separted by two vertical lines. The piece is covered with transparent bluish glze that pools in areas.
