Wide-mouthed bowl with slightly everted lip and narrow rounded footring which has been glazed over. The inside of the footring is unglazed exposing some areas of the biscuit body and reddish clay body (kiln waste). Coarsely

crackled olive-green glaze with areas showing absorption of red-colored earth sediments.
