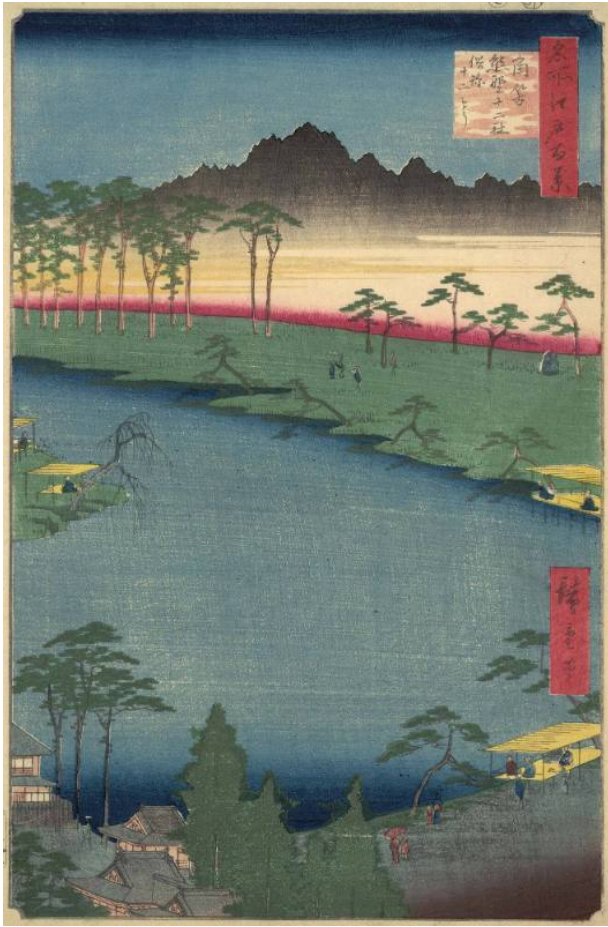


Basic Detail Report

Description

In late Edo period, the shrine combined appeals of powerful deities and a scenic site; tea stalls line the banks, a restaurant is in the lower left, indicating a space of entertainment and summer retreat; scratchy pattern left in the blue expanse of the pond is the mark of a damaged baren, evidence of the hand of an anonymous printer.
