Stoneware with greyish-blue glaze

Description

Shallow in shape, with curved spreading sides above a low foot, the rim and base both glazed and imbedded with kiln grit. Body unknown, covered with greyish-blue glaze, the latter a light blue where heavily dripped on outside. White inlaid decoration inside of chrysanthemum and foliage beneath a border pattern within concentric rings, the

diagonal marks within presumably deriving from rinceau pattern (as 65.279). Outside, four roundels with chrysanthemum heads in white inlay, foliage in black. Outside: four chrysanthemums with small amount of black foliage inlaid within two concentric circles; double concentric circles above base and below mouth rim.
