Grey porcellanous stoneware with grey-green glaze

Description

Thinly potted with gently rounded spreading sides above medium-high foot. Foot rim and base both fully glazed, the latter with three quartz pebble-like spur marks. Interior, a moulded pattern evenly impressed of pomegranate flowers and foliage below a circular slip band of dots. A spiral flower inside base. A similar decoration appears on a bowl now at Syracuse University, illustrated Korean Ceramics p. 53, 64.542. another is in the Victoria and Albert Museum and described p. 30 by Bernard Rackham, Catalogue of the Le Blond Collection.,
