Six-lobed bowl

Description

Like an open six-petalled flower, marked at the center with a deeply cut ring, which belies the size of the smaller

foot ring beneath. The walls inside and outside are devoid of any design. The bowl is covered with a crackled pale blue glaze which fills the deeply cut ring inside with a deeper shade and acquires a slightly greenish tinge where thick at the center. The interior of the base is left unglazed, disclosing the white porcelain body which is tinged with pink from the influx of oxygen into the kiln after firing.
