Description

Jar with wide cup-shaped mouth on low neck on high shoulder carrying two small angular loop handles which have been inserted into holes drilled into body. High body with tapering sides and flat unglazed iron-red base. Cup mouth rim unglazed but interior of cup and all of exterior

is covered with thick putty colored glaze which is degraded on lower half of body. Frasche #700.
