Description

Tri-partite composition with each section separated by water or cloud motif. A shallow foreground is occupied by three trees on a rocky platform; the middle ground has the most "human" interests: footbridge, cottages with two men seated facing each other, trees, boats, and a path leading to a pavilion on a hill; a range of mountains with prominent peaks and a waterfall in the background. Inscription and seals of the Chen Yuanqi are copied on the upper left. Translation: see curatorial file.
