Description

Large wine jar with high, wide bulging shoulders, short vertical neck and wide mouth. Bottom tapers to a foot rim. Buff body with white slip and transparent glaze.

Reddish-brown painted designs. Floral band decorates the shoulders. Bands of parallel lines enclosing one squiggly line decorates the base. One side decorated with a boldly-painted dragon, the other side with a phoenix. These two designs separated on either side by a floral pattern. Fairly good condition. One large crack up the side goes from the rim to the base underfoot; repaired. A.B. 4-77
