A birds' eye view of the Ming imperial tombs which is located on the northern hills of the capital of Beijing. Above each mausoleum is an inscription naming the emperor buried there. Landscape elements are hand-colored in blue-green pigment. Architectural elements, such as gateways, bridges, sculpture and buildings are depicted with exactitude in fine-line drawings.
