Gourd shaped vase with large bottom, cinched waist and small top. Tubular neck and splayed foot ring. Decorated with white slip designs--striped border on neck, floral pattern on top portion, and combed leaf border design on upper part of bottom portion. Grey-green celadon glaze. One-inch hole in side. Lop-sided. Very good condition. Five small chips in the glaze on neck. A.B. 5/77
