Round bronze medal with high-level relief decoration on the front and back. The obverse features Gloria (Glory) personified by the figure of Cupid who is seen walking with wings outspread, holding a wreath of laurel leaves in each hand. The reverse features Fama or fame symbolized by the image of a cicada. Raised dots or darts are seen surrounding the edge.
