Standing on a foot rim and having curved, tapering sides, wide rolled lip rim and stylized lotus flowers and water or wave pattern molded in raised line form on exterior. Flowers, leaves and wave forms filled with green and yellow glazes on the dark blue glazing of the bowl itself in the Fa'hua technique.
