Porcellanous, club-shaped vase; standing on high everted foot stem, having a flat, rounded body, tall concave neck and everted lip rim. Decorated with incised parallel lines on neck and body and with high relief animal masks with mock rings on shoulders. Also called Ch'ing-pai/Qingbai ware, now the preferred term (MWY)
