Male Song tomb figurine. The statue wears a tall hat and a well defined tunic. The sleeves drop down to the knees and the feet protrude out from beneath the skirt. The official has pronounced eyes that extend back towards the top of his ears. His hands meet near the middle of his body and the fingers are visibly interlaced.
