Transparent glazed high-fired stoneware decorated in underglaze iron-black
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Description

Lid embellished with relief forms of the stem and leaves of a mangosteen fruit. Alternating reserves of scrolling and crosshatched motifs separated by vertical lines. Horizontal bands above and below the area of decoration. Pale translucent grey glaze stops short of the flat unglazed foot. Interior of lid unglazed. Interior of box shows remnants of glaze.
