Description

Facsimile of a Chinese Sung dynasty Northern celadon bowl. Stoneware with crackled green celadon glaze over an impressed mold design (stylized floral motif). Indented bottom is glazed and inscribed with maker's mark. Made by Mr. Tichane (Corning, N.Y.) The impressed decoration on this bowl is taken from an original Sung dynasty mold in the collection of the Metropolitan Museum of Art.
