Description

Flattened lid with no finial, decorated with a band of radiating leaf motifs enclosed in double concentric rings. Sawtooth pattern at the edge of the lid, inside of lid unglazed. Body decorated in scrolling and leaf motifs in a band formed by three lines above and below. Narrow slightly splayed foot, indented unglazed base. Interior glazed.
