Description

Male Song tomb figurine. Wears a visibly red tunic with white trimmed collar and cuffs and white shoes extend out from beneath the robe. Hands are clasped beneath the robe and not visible. Face maintains definition as does the lines that define the hair on his head. Wears an oblong bun on the very top of his head. Appears to have undergone some repairs. There are two cracks near the knees.
