Description

Small gray stoneware bowl on a high, flared foot ring, with lid. Throw-lines are visible on both bowl and lid, and each has parallel, incised, circumferential lines. The top of the

lid has a pointed knob. Brownish glaze is speckled over the lid and one side of the bowl. Several air bubbles in the clay produced bulges during firing. Rough, light brown kiln grit has adhered to lower portion of bowl.
