Pair of inlaid iron stirrups

Iron, inlaid with silver and mother of pearl

Description

Pair of iron stirrups, called "abumi", inlaid with silver (hollyhock or pauwlonia?) leaf patterns on the outside and with small mother of pearl triangles on the inside (footbed, or area where the foot rests). Loops at the top would have been attached to the saddle by leather straps. Stirrups are inscribed with maker's signature on front flange.
