Large Guangala hollow statue in the form of a kneeling woman. Figure wears a large headdress with elaborate incised decoration, long dangling earrings, a nose ring, a wide collar-like necklace, bracelets, and a short skirt. Areas of incised decoration on upper arms may indicate body painting or tattoos. Burnished redware; broken and extensively restored on back. El Junco, Manabi
